LADYBUGS!

SUPPLIES:

- 1. 1 Styrofoam ball
- 2. 3 Black pipe cleaners
- 3. 2 Google eyes
- 4. Red and black paint
- 5. Scissors, pen or pencil, glue, paintbrush
- 6. A wooden skewer or extra paintbrush. A glass a bit taller than the skewer or paintbrush

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Press a wooden skewer or paintbrush into the bottom of the styrofoam ball. This will help you paint the whole ball without getting your hands messy.
- 2. Paint the ball red and place in a glass that's a bit taller than the skewer to dry completely
- 3. Glue on the google eyes
- 4. Paint 4 black spots onto the ladybug's back. Place in the glass to dry completely
- Cut 1 black pipe cleaner in half. Twist each half around a pencil to make a curley antenna. Using the pencil lead press 2 small holes into the ball where you want to put your antennae. Then press the pipe cleaners into the holes
- 6. Cut 2 black pipe cleaners in half. Now cut each of those pieces in half. You will have 8 pieces, but will use only 6 for the legs.
- 7. Using the pencil lead press 3 holes on each side of the styrofoam body for the legs. Press the pipe cleaners into the holes and bend them to make feet!
